Choose a research topic: consider what aspect of the ancient world you are interested in, what you enjoy and what you would like to learn more about.	Develop research skills: learn how to find and evaluate sources, select relevant information and keep track of what you learn.	Make a plan: find how to plan creatively and how to set realistic goals, break down tasks and keep yourself on track.	Have a clear plan of action which is based on independent research into a topic of your choice.
